In the article class the title text printed by \begin{thebibliography} is given by the value of \refname (default References), while in the report and chapter classes the text is given by the value of \bibname (default Bibliography).

The command $setbibref{\langle name \rangle}$ will set the title text for the Bibliography or the References to ' $\langle name \rangle$ ' for at least the article, report and book standard ET_EX classes, without having to be concerned which class is being used.

If you are using the babel package, put \setbibref{...} after the \begin{document}.
